Ordered by the court that Jury venue be appointed to mark and lay off a road the nearest and best way from William Crain, to intersect the road leading to Carthage the said jury being first sworn and report to next court. Lundon Shoemake, John Price, Moses Linville, **William Rotten**, Alexander Lowery, Jacob Anderson, William Crain —.
