Content of record:

This day came the parties by their attornies [sic] and thereupon came a jury of good and lawful men To wit:
Jesse Dodrow, Woodson P. White, William Belcher, William Shaw, Charles Hutchings, **Garrett Fitzgerald**,
Uriah Murphy, James Simpson, Thomas Sherly, Micajah Johnston, William Parkison, and Spruce Mitchell who
being tested tried and sworn the truth to speak cause continued until next term of court.

Comment: Did no attorney ask Garrett Fitzgerald whether he would be biased in his jury service in this case brought by his near-kin?
