The Defendant being solemnly charged pleads not guilty, afterwards came Jury to wit: William Boyce, Nathan Ward, Benjamin Coyle, James Coyle, John Sratt, John Taylor, Jr., Alexander Cook, Samuel Terry, **Garrett Fitzgerald**, Thomas Taylor, Daniel Morris and **William Roaden** being enpannelled and sworn after retiring find the defendant guilty of an "assault" only, and is fined in the sum of Twenty-five Dollars, and the costs. And ordered in custody of the sheriff till paid. Fifteen dollars of the above fine remitted by the Court. The above defendant John Perkins is released from the custody of the Sheriff and ordered by the Court that facias issued against him for the fine and costs.
