Bryan, Isham Bradley, Landon Shoemake, Nathan Wilkinson, Joel Bradshaw, William Clary, Elijah Ward, Joseph Brown, George Upton, James Moore and **Jabez Fitzgerald**, Evans Jonah who being elected tried and sworn will and truly to inquire of Damages in this suit on their oaths do say that the plaintiff recover against the Defendant Five hundred Dollars Damages of. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the Defendant his Damages aforesaid in form aforesaid assessed—and his cost by him about this suit this behalf expended and the said Deft in mercy of.
