This day came the parties by their attornies [sic] and a jury of good and lawful men to wit:  
James R. Bryan, Isham Bradley, Landon Shoemake, John Waller, Joel Bradshaw, William Clarey, Elijah Ward,  
Robert Glenn, George Upton, James Moore, **Jabez Fitzgerald**, Ericus Smith who being elected tried and sworn the  
truth to speak on their oaths do say they find for the plaintiff twenty-eight Dollars, Sixteen and two thirds cents. It is  
therefore considered by the court that the plaintiff recover the sum aforesaid in form aforesaid assessed and his  
costs in this suit in that behalf expended. And the Defendant in mercy of.

Ordered by the Court that Joseph Walling stock mark be recorded and is as follows to wit: a crop and slit in  
the right and crop in the left of.

Ordered by the Court that Isham Russell stock mark be recorded & is as follows to wit: a swallow fork in  
the right and crop and over bit in the left.
