**Content of record:**

Present the worshipfull [sic] Robert Armstrong, Thomas Crutchen, Joseph Smith, William Erwin & John Bryan, Esq. Jus-  
tices. This day came the parties by their attornies [sic] and thereupon came a jury of good and lawful men to wit: John Gra-  
ham, John Sownd, John Anderson, Elijah Lewis, William Daniel, **William Rotton**, Philip Huggins, William Burden,  
Andrew Bryan, James Bryan, John Harper and William Hayes, who being elected tried and sworn the truth to speak, upon  
the issue joined upon their oaths do say of . In this cause one of the Jury men is withdrawn, and the rest of the Jury are re-  
leased from rendering their verdict and the cause is continued till next court.

**Comment:** I simply could not determine the surname of the second jury man. It appeared to read *John Sownd*.
