This day came the parties by their attornies [sic] and thereof came a jury of good and lawful men to wit: William Clary, Isham Bradley, John Walling, Joel Bradsh[aw], James Moore, Solomon Burford, Joab Scallion, Elijah Ward, Robert Glenn, William Foster, Ericus Smith, **Jabez Fitzgerald** who being elected, tried and sworn [to] try the issue joined upon their oaths do say they fine the plaintiff four dollars damages and costs. Judgmt. Accordingly.
