To be entered for the plaintiff against the defendant and his sureties — This day came the plaintiff by his attorney so came **William Rottan** and William Ridge his sureties by their attornies [sic], who being fully heard it is considered by the court that the motion aforesaid be overruled and that that Defendant recover against the plaintiff his cost by him about their defense in this behalf expended.
