This day came the plaintiff by his attorney Thomas K. Harris and there upon came a Jury of good and lawful men to wit: Jacob Anderson Senr., David McDaniel, **Richard M. Rottan**, James Townsend, Richard Hill, Robert Howard, Robert Puckett, Henry Lyda, Spence Mitchell, George Sugg, John Williams and John Crook Senr. who being elected tried and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue joined upon this oaths do say that the plaintiff recover against the defendant one hundred and twelve dollars in Damages in the Scire facias mentioned and costs therein mentioned together with all lawful costs in this behalf expended. It is therefore considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant his Damages aforesaid in form aforesaid assessed together with his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended and the said Defendant in Mercy etc.
