**Content of cause:** Ordered by the Court that John Rose, Bird Smith, Benjamin Lewis, Ericus Smith, Thomas Crutchen, Thomas Bounds, James McClure, Alexander Lowry, William Ridge, David McDaniel, Andrew Gamble, Aaron England, Issac Midcalf, William Irwin, Alexander Cook, Joseph Cummings, Abraham Broyles, Nicholas Gillentine, John Ogle, **William Rottan**, Thomas Meek, Jacob Robinson, Reuben Ragland, David Mitchell, Joseph Franks, Robert G. Anderson, William Lewis, Elias Wallis, William Gist, Thompson Simpson, Thomas Willow, Samuel Johnston, John Porter, William Smith, Thomas Hume, Andrew McBride, Robert Armstrong, John M. Carrick and William Glenn appear before the Honorable the Circuit County of the County of White to be held in Sparta on the first Monday in March next, then and there to serve as Jurors and then and there to attend from day to day until discharged by the Court and that a *venire facias* issue.

**Comment:** *Venire facias* is used as the name of the writ for summoning a jury. The list of jurors is summoned to serve as jurors for a particular term. A special venire is sometimes prepared for a protracted case. —*Black's Law Dictionary*, Fifth Edition (1979), 1395
