West Texas Cauble-Rotan **Family Day**

Fifty-three descendants and friends gathered on 24 July 1999 in the hall of the Roby United Methodist Church in Fisher County, Texas, with Aubry Nell and Kiefer Cauble H2361 as hosts. This reunion must be called a meeting of the descendants of William Rotan (died 1845 TN) and his wife, Rosey, of White County, Tennessee. Mary Ann Rotan (1794 SC-1860 TX), who married Peter Cauble (1786 NC-1870 TX), was a daughter of Rosey and William Rotan. John A. Rotan (1796 SC-by 1853 Tyler Co.,TX) was a close kinsman of the couple, but his exact kinship is not yet known. Rotan descendants who attended this family day were descended from John A. Rotan.

Although this meeting seemed doomed early in the week when we learned that we could not meet at the original location, it turned out to be the best reunion the writer [who has attended each and every one over the last thirteen years] has ever attended. The hall of the Methodist Church was just the right size and the food was really good. But, the best part was the excitement of those who attended. Above: Lillian Rotan (25 Dec 1865 McLennan Co. TX-04 Jan 1958) and Neal Reed (10 Sep 1851 McLennan Co. TX-27 Mar 1924 Sterling Co. TX), who married on 25 November 1888 in McLennan County and came to Sterling County in 1889, where they established their ranch in 1890. The couple had six children and worked hard all their lives. Lillian was a daughter of Clotelia B. McGee (1844 Louisiana-16 May 1878 McLennan Co. TX) and William T. Rotan (1835 Mississippi-after 21 Dec 1882), who married 02 February 1865 in McLennan County. William T. Rotan was a son of John A. Rotan (1794 South Carolina-by October 1858 Tyler County, Texas). Lillian, her brother, William Rotan (born 1868), and her sister, Annie Rotan (born 1875), were raised by relatives after the untimely death of their mother. 
