
After the business meeting, door and special prizes were handed out, followed by an arts and crafts

Patrick Rudolf Levý E13613 (14 April 1967 Fort Ord, California-8 August 2012 Austin, Texas; cremated), a son of Jane Garrett E1361 and Rudolf Victory Levý (1930-2001), attended The University of Texas in Austin, where he was an accomplished diver with the Longhorn Aquatics Diving Club and The University of Texas diving team. Patrick worked as a

diving clown off a 100-foot platform in Barcelona, Spain, after the 1992 Olympic Games. He also made several stunt dives off Mansfield Dam for a movie. He was an adventurous man who loved life. Patrick searched for spiritual peace, which his family feels he found with his beloved Golden Retriever, **Deuce**, and his family by his bed when he departed this life. Patrick's memorial service will be held on 6 October 2012 at Bethany United Methodist Church on Anderson Mill Road in Austin. Patrick is survived by his mother, **Jane Garrett Levý**, his sister, **Laurie Levý E13611**, his brother, **Andrew Levý E13612**, a large extended family across Texas, and a host of friends.
